What is Youth Bible Drill?

Youth Bible Drill is a competition for youth, where young people are able to develop skills that will help them take a stand for Christ in their churches, at school, in their workplaces, and in their communities.

The following are expected results of participating in Bible Drill:

- Developing skills in the use of the Bible
- Able to locate books of the Bible.
- Able to locate Scripture references.
- Able to identify Scriptures.
- To provide biblical knowledge, enabling young people to see the relevance of the Bible in today's world.

YOUTH BIBLE DRILL IS DIVIDED INTO 3 PARTS

- Bible Books Drill
- Scripture Searching Drill
- Verse Identification Drill

Bible Books Drill

The drill leader will call the name of a book in the Bible. When "Start" is called, you will begin searching for the book that was called. Locate the book called, place your index finger on any page in that book, and then step forward. When called upon, you should be able to name the book which immediately precedes the book called, the book called, and the book which immediately follows the book called.

The drill leader will give participants 10 seconds before calling "TIME". Once "TIME" has been called the participants who stepped forward will be called on individually and will be asked to name the preceding book, the called book, and the book which follows.

Those participants who do not step forward will remain quiet. (Drill Duration is 10 min)

Scripture Searching Drill

The drill leader will announce a Scripture reference to be found. Scripture-searching drills are taken from any part of the Bible. You must correctly locate the scripture reference and place your index finger on the verse before you step forward. When called upon, you must be able to read the verse and state the scripture reference.

The drill leader will give participants 15 seconds before calling "TIME." Once "TIME" has been called, the participants who stepped forward will be called on individually and will be asked to read the verse and state the scripture reference. Those participants who do not step forward will remain quiet. (Drill Duration is 10 min.)

Verse Identification Drill

The drill leader will quote a part of a verse taken from the list of verses provided by YUFC. It may be any part of the verse. The drill leader will quote enough of the verse to provide you with a reasonable clue. You must locate the scripture reference and place your index finger on the verse before you step forward. When called upon, you must be able to read the verse and state the scripture reference.

The drill leader will give participants 15 seconds before calling "TIME. Once "TIME" has been called the participants who stepped forward will be called on individually and will be asked to recite the verse and scripture reference. Those participants who do not step forward will remain quiet. (Drill Duration is 10 min)

SPANISH DRILLS

The option is open for any district to also hold a Bible Drill competition in Spanish. These drills will be run in the same manner as their English language counterparts with the only difference being the official Bible version. For the Spanish language drills, **the official Bible version is the Reina-Valera 1960, whereas the English language official Bible is the New American Standard Bible (NASB).** The Spanish verses will be disseminated with the English verses. It is possible to hold two separate Bible Drill competition (one in English and one in Spanish). In this case, the final scores would determine who goes to Nationals at the YUFC National Convention.

Competition will be held on the District Levels and then on the National Level. There will be a registration fee of \$7.00.
